Anchors: 27lb Nansen plough on 270ft cable
Danforth on 30ft cable and 300ft rope

Electronic: Tiller pilot, Sounder, VHF, Handheld GPS, 83watt solar panel (new)

Tender: Archilles inflatable (poor condition)
